Minimum requirements for a GMAT or GRE waiver consideration:

- 1. An advanced degree with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (e.g., masters or higher), OR
2. A cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or higher or an undergraduate grade point average of 3.0 in the last 60 semester or 90 quarter hours, AND
3. At least eight years of full-time professional experience that shows increased responsibility over the scope of your career.
