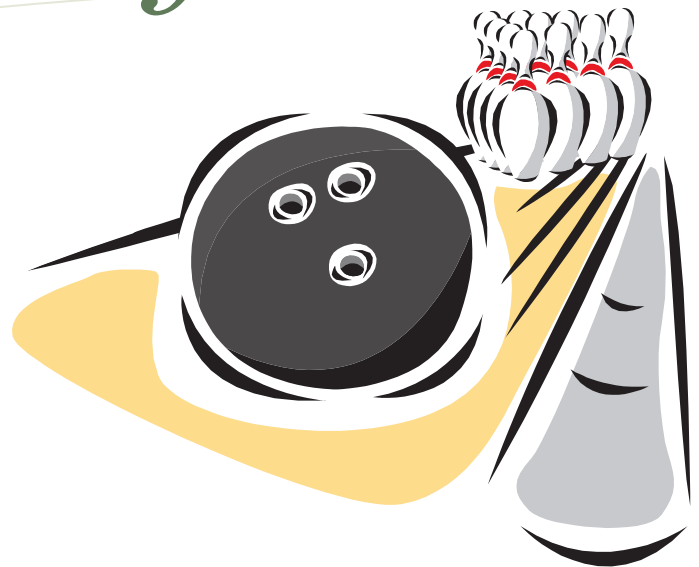
Welcome Back!

COB Priority Advising

Priority Advising will be the week of February 20-24th. To take advantage of Priority Advising, you must schedule your appointment by 12:00 P.M. on February 10th.

To schedule your priority advising appointment:

Call the Undergraduate Programs Office (970) 491-5103.

Say that you are “**Priority Advising**,” and have your student ID number, phone number, email, and preferred/available appointment times ready to share.

If you choose to use the online appointment scheduler, the system will not allow you to schedule an appointment during the priority advising week as all advisors block their calendars to save room for the priority students. Therefore, you will only be able to select an appointment time within the next two weeks, just like everybody else. This also means that you may get an appointment before the priority advising week, which is fine.

If you wait until after noon (12:00 P.M.) on February 10th you will schedule your advising appointment with your advisor in the normal manner by using the online appointment scheduler at <http://www.csubz.us/adsced>.

COB Mentoring Scholarship

Deadline: March 1st (mentees must have applied on CSUSA by this date to be considered!)

The COB Mentoring Program announces the COB Mentoring Scholarship for 2012-2013. The program is dedicated to student success and wishes to continue student involvement after freshmen year. One freshman participant will be eligible to receive this scholarship for sophomore year. This cyclic program allows a mentee in the program to be a COB Mentor in her/his junior or senior year.

***This is a recognition/prestigious scholarship. The mentee chosen will have her/his photo and biography put on the Mentoring Website. The scholar will also be encouraged to highlight this honor on a resume. It is NOT about the money, but the recognition.**

The COB Mentoring Program Scholarship will be awarded to one mentee for 2012-2013. Students must:

- Fill out the CSU Scholarship Application (CSUSA) on Ramweb
 - ★ Specify that you are applying for the COB Mentoring Scholarship and are a mentee in 11-12
 - Have a **letter of recommendation from your mentor**
 - Please turn this into the Program Coordinator (Katie Ditter) in 176 Rockwell Hall
 - She will accept the Mentor Letter of Recommendation up until Friday, March 2nd at 5 PM**
 - Participated in Mentoring events throughout the year
 - ★ Tracked by Program Coordinator
 - ★ Have a 3.00 cumulative GPA
 - ★ Must be a Business Administration Major for 2012-2013
- Scholarship recipients will be encouraged to become a mentor during junior or senior year at CSU.

The deadline to apply for scholarships is March 1 at 11 p.m. (MST). Go to RAMweb at ramweb.colostate.edu and login using your eID. Then select the CSU Scholarship Application link. Be sure to complete your college's section of the CSUSA.

To be considered for need-based scholarships through the CSUSA, your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be submitted no later than March 1. The COB Mentoring Scholarship is not a need-based scholarship.

The scholarship recipient will be announced at the end of the spring 2012 semester at the End of the Year Mentoring Event.
